Butts County 4–H has successfully served over 200 fifth grade students by providing hands–on interactive lessons in STEM education in each of the elementary schools in the county. In addition, a team of students represented the county in the Cotton Boll and Consumer Judging competition, showcasing their talents and knowledge. More than 35 students participated in summer camps, and the county also offered many summer fun activities, such as soap–making and water activities, to keep the students engaged and entertained. The county managed to fund these summer activities through successful fundraisers like the poinsettia sales for the holidays and the spring jewelry sale.


